During Raymond's early career as a civil engineer he worked on construction projects as varied as sea defences, sewage works and airfields. During 10 years with the former Central Electricity Generating Board (CEGB) he specialised in geotechnical engineering in the design and construction of coal fired and nuclear power stations. As manager in the CEGB By-Products Department he was responsible for R&D into concrete technology, representation on British and European working groups for cementitious products and the exploitation of pulverised fuel ash as a valuable by-product.

Having acquired a law degree, while working full-time, Raymond was later enticed into the legal profession and trained as a solicitor specialising in construction and engineering law. He has been a partner in two international law firms and established his own legal firm and is currently a consultant to Freeths LLP. In addition to contract drafting he is experienced in litigation, injunctive relief and adjudication. He is now regularly appointed as an adjudicator in construction disputes and is a trained and experienced mediator. He has been a trusted business advisor to many of his clients where his advice has been sought, on among other matters, corporate governance, shareholder disputes, fraud, competition issues and investigations into the conduct of directors, senior employees and trustees.

Raymond has been the Chairman of the Midlands Association of the Institution of Civil Engineers (ICE) and was, until recently, Chairman for four years of the ICE Disputes Resolution Panel, of which he is still a member.

He is the author of several health and safety law books and a book on the Housing Grants, Construction and Regeneration Act 1996.
